

Regulation of
**BOULDERING CHAMPIONSHIP
 OF BALTIC STATES 2009**

1 Organisation

The competition is organized by Latvian Alpinist Association, Lithuania Climbing Sport Association and Tallinn Climbing club (Estonia)

1. Target of championship.

- Award the title of Bouldering champion of Baltic states to strongest participants
- Increase importance of each particular event
- Increase over border participation in each particular event

2 Participation.

Competitions are held in one group for men and women:

Group A - from 16 years (1993 and older)

3 Provisional competition programme:

Competitions will take place in three rounds each held in Riga, Vilnius and Tallinn

4 Rules

The rules of each individual competition are regulated by organizers and their competition regulations. For the result in each individual event participants will receive scores according to table bellow:

If in event participates less then 30 participants, then from every result are subtracted points that other ways would be given to the next participant according to the results that didn't participate in event. Example: 20 people participated. For 21st place 10 points are given. That means that winner receives 90 points, 2nd place 70 points, 3rd – 55.....20th place 2 points

Scores of events are summed together and 3 the best results for men and women receive title of Champion of Baltic states in Bouldering, diplomas and cups.

All costs for participation in Bouldering championship of Baltic States are covered by participants.
